

KINGDOM OF CALLAWAY COUNTY FAIR TRUCK PULL 2008

Pure Stock and Street Modified Truck Pulling Contest

RULES WILL ALSO BE USED AT MOKANES WORLD FAIR

Class 1	5800 lb. Pure Stock
Class 2	6200 lb. Pure Stock
Class 3	5800 lb. Modified Stock
Class 4	6200 lb. Modified Stock
Class 5	Diesel Class
Class 6	Diesel Modified Class

Premiums paid in each Class; 1st, 2nd & 3rd, 50% pay out
Each Puller will pay a \$20 Hook fee per class entered, limited to (2) hooks only, \$12 Pit Pass.

RULES AND REULATIONS

- 1 Operators must have a valid Missouri driver's license, current insurance card, plates and vehicle inspection sticker.
- 2 Contestants must be at least 18 year of age.
- 3 The possession or use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in by the Kingdom of Callaway County Fair board. Violators of this rule will forfeit all premiums and will be escorted off the Fair grounds. This rule **will be enforced**.
- 4 Contest will be open to 4 wheel drive vehicles with rubber tires; no tire chains, studs or duals wheels.
- 5 Each vehicle may be entered in no more than two classes: but only once in each class.
- 6 Truck must hook within 3 minutes of when the sled is ready or it will be disqualified from the class.
- 7 Contest to be governed by judges with all decisions final. Judge has the right to stop and disqualify any vehicles if it is not being operated in such a manner as would be considered safe.
- 8 Operator must remain seated with at least one hand on the steering wheel at all times. All trucks must be equipped with an operable seat belt. Seat belt must be fastened during the pull.
- 9 Decisions of the judges are final.
- 10 Pull track will be a total of 250 feet with 150 feet of shut down area.
- 11 Truck that pulls the sled the greatest distance will be the winner. In the event of a tie, a pull off will determine the winner.
- 12 All trucks must have current safety glass in the windshield and rear window.
- 13 All truck frames must be of the same manufacture as the body being used.
- 14 All trucks must have working brake system.
- 15 Driveline brakes will be allowed for as a secondary braking system for safety.
- 16 All trucks must have a reverse light on the back of the truck.
- 17 All trucks will be inspected before the pull. Anyone protesting an inspection must put up \$100.00 fee, if the truck is legal the fair judges will retain the fee. If it is found illegal the protesting driver will get his fee back and the other driver will be out of the pulling contest.

Contest Rules

- 1 Pull position will be determined at the time of registration by pulling numbers.
- 2 Number one puller in each last will be considered a test pull. If there is a problem this contestant will be allowed to re-pull in the last position in the class. The decision to re-pull must be made before the puller unhooks from his first run.
- 3 In the event of a sled problem the puller will have the same rights stated in rule 2.
- 4 All pulls must start with a tight hitch, no jerking permitted. Contestants will be allowed 2 consecutive attempts and 75 feet to start the sled. Spinouts will not be eligible for a second attempt within the first 75 feet.

- 5 Excessive loss of liquid by the vehicle, while in motion during the contest, will be cause for disqualification, unless due to internal breakage.
- 6 All pulls during the contest will be measured.
- 7 No portion of the vehicle may interfere with the sled hitch or sled during the pull.
- 8 Vehicle must remain in boundaries of the contest course during the pull or you will be disqualified.
- 9 All vehicles pulling in a class must remain in the pit area at all times.
- 10 Any ballast or external parts lost while truck is hitched to sled will be disqualified. All weights must be secured. **NO LOOSE WEIGHTS ALLOWED**
- 11 No one allowed on the track officials contestants. One assistant will be allowed at the starting line to assist the driver. Assistant must be over 18 years old. Any violation of this rule will result in disqualification of contestant.
- 12 Each contestant may provide one hitch man to indicate position of the sled before start of previous pull to track crew. The sled will not be moved after it has returned to start line.
- 13 Vehicle will not be allowed more than one entry in the same class with a different driver.
- 14 No riders allowed in any class.
- 15 All pullers should be neatly attired with safety in mind.
- 16 It will be mandatory for all drivers to attend a drivers' meeting prior to pull. Any violation of this rule will result in disqualification of contestant.
- 17 Use of profanity or threats by any puller or members of his crew toward officials or other pullers will result in disqualification of the contestant and crew.
- 18 All drivers must follow the directions of the track officials during pull from start to finish.

Truck Specifications

- 1 Vehicles must be factory equipped 4 wheel drive vehicles.
- 2 Wheelbase cannot be altered in any class. Trucks will be limited to standard cab or extended cab, NO CREW CABS ALLOWED. Pick-ups must have functional beds and factory bumpers in place.
- 3 Bumper must be standard equipment as intended by manufacturer with a clevis in place to hitch to the sled. **(Clevis's must be 1/2" minimum)**
- 5 All trucks must have factory doors and windows.
- 6 All trucks must have hood and grille in place as intended by manufacturer.
- 7 Four wheel truck vehicles may run without tailgate or rear door for safer hitch point visibility.
- 8 The use of torque converters, automatic shifts, etc. will be permitted.
- 9 Wheel rims must be standard widths, with no duals permitted.
- 10 All drivers must wear helmets in modified classes.
- 11 Fire extinguisher will be required in all modified classes.

Pure Stock Class Rules 5800 and 6200 lb.

- 1 Factory 4 wheel drive vehicles only.
- 2 Tires must be factory equipment only up to 33x12.50. (No cutting of Tires)
- 3 Engine, related equipment and drive train must be factory pure stock equipment for the year it was manufactured.
- 4 Must have pure stock manifolds and mufflers
- 5 Stock trucks will not be allowed to have any fuel injection, carburetor or intake modifications. **NO HEADERS ALLOW**
- 6 Stock trucks run stock fuel. If officials' smell racing fuel, the truck in question will be disqualified; entry fee and prize money will be forfeited.
- 7 Pure Stock means Stock only. This means zero modifications from what was intended by the manufacturer of the vehicle.
- 8 5800 lb. vehicles will be allowed to weigh up to 6000 lb.. and 6200 lb. vehicles will not be allowed to weigh over that.
- 9 Vehicles must be driven into the pit area. **NO TRAILERED VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED.**
- 10 No Ballast period. (This means no extra weights anywhere on the vehicle)
- 11 Truck must run pump gas no higher than 93 octane. Any other additives or racing fuel smells

will result in disqualification.

Street Legal Modified Class Rules 5800 and 6200 lb.

- 1 Any cubic inch displacement. Engine must be naturally aspirated only. No blowers or turbo. Must be 4 wheel drive vehicle.
- 2 One carburetor, no fuel injection on 1986 or older vehicles.
- 3 D.O.T.tires no larger than 33x12.50, No cut tires and no suspension blocks allowed. **(No Duals)**
- 4 Modification allowed; manifold, fuel system, camshafts, ignition system, headers, computer chips, engine and truck body must be the same manufacturer.
- 5 Stock trucks run stock fuel. If officials' smell racing fuel, the truck in question will be disqualified; entry fee and prize money will be forfeited. Must be no higher than 93 octane pumped gas.
- 6 Vehicles must be driven into the pit area. NO TRAILERED VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 7 Modification not allowed; multiple carburetors, aluminum cylinder heads, nitrous oxide systems, super chargers or alcohol fuel
- 8 5800 lb. vehicles will be allowed to weigh up to 6000 lb.. and 6200 lb. vehicles will not be allowed to weigh over that.
- 9 Ballast must be solid type, securely attached, mounted no higher and no wider than the general profile of the vehicle.
- 10 Front end weights may not extend further forward than 60 inches from the center of the front axle.

Pure Stock Diesel Class

- 1 Factory 4 wheel drive vehicles only.
- 2 Tires must be factory equipment only. **(No Duals Allowed)**
- 3 Engine, related equipment and drive train must be factory pure stock equipment for the year it was manufactured.
- 4 Must have pure stock manifolds and mufflers
- 5 Stock trucks will not be allowed to have any fuel injection, carburetor or intake modifications. **(NO HEADERS ALLOW OR COMPUTER CHIPS)**
- 6 Stock trucks run stock fuel. If officials' smell racing fuel, the truck in question will be disqualified; entry fee and prize money will be forfeited.
- 7 Pure Stock means Stock only. This means zero modifications from what was intended by the manufacturer of the vehicle.
- 8 Vehicles must be driven into the pit area. NO TRAILERED VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 9 No Ballast period. (This means no extra weights anywhere on the vehicle)

Modified Street Legal Diesel Class

- 1 Any cubic inch displacement. Engine must be naturally aspirated only. Unless Turbo or Blowers are factory equipment put on by the manufacturer. Must be 4 wheel drive vehicle.
- 2 One carburetor, no fuel injection on 1987 or older vehicles.
- 3 Tires 36" D.O.T., No cut tires and no suspension blocks allowed. **(No Duals Allowed)**
- 4 Modification allowed; manifold, fuel system, camshafts, ignition system, headers, computer chips, engine and truck body must be the same manufacturer.
- 5 Stock trucks run stock fuel. If officials' smell racing fuel, the truck in question will be disqualified; entry fee and prize money will be forfeited.
- 6 Vehicles must be driven into the pit area. NO TRAILERED VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 7 Modification not allowed; multiple carburetors, aluminum cylinder heads, nitrous oxide systems, super chargers or alcohol fuel
- 8 Ballast must be solid type, securely attached, mounted no higher and no wider than the general profile of the vehicle.
- 9 Front end weights may not extend further forward than 60 inches from the center of the front axle.
