

Miss Callaway & JR Miss Callaway County Fair Queen Contest Rules:

The Callaway County Fair Pageant competition is held within the guidelines of the Missouri State Fair Queen Pageant rules and regulations. Entrants agree that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely at the discretion of the Callaway County Fair Board and the decision of the judges will be final.

1. Contestants shall be citizens of the United States and female residents of Callaway County for not less than six months immediately preceding July 1, 2010.
2. Contestants must be single, between the ages of 17 and 22 years of age by September 1, 2010. Junior Miss Callaway contestants must be between the ages of 13 and 16 years of age by September 1, 2010.
3. Submit a complete entry by July 6 which includes the following:
 - a. \$25.00 entry fee.
 - b. Completed entry form.
4. Each contestant will be judged based on the following scoring basis:
 - a. Personal Interviews –40%
 - b. Public Speaking or Talent Performance- 40%
(3 minute presentation. 1 point penalty will be deducted for each second over the time limit, per state rules.)
 - c. Evening Gown -20% - (Optional for Jr Miss Callaway contestants).
5. Conduct deemed to be improper and detrimental to the Callaway County Fair or the Queen Pageant will be reason for disqualification and/or dismissal.
6. The Callaway County Fair Queen Pageant director has the right to revise the rules in order to meet the needs of the competition.

Obligations:

1. If crowned Miss Callaway, or Junior Miss Callaway, you will be expected to be present at the fair each evening to promote events during the different venues that are taking place at the fair.
2. The queens should attend the Callaway County Fair Ham Breakfast on Saturday, August 7th, 2010. ***This is an early morning event.***
3. The queens are expected to ride in the winter Fulton parade for 2010.
4. Miss Callaway County Fair Queen may compete at the Missouri State Fair Queen Contest in Sedalia.
 - a. Her entry fees will be paid by the Callaway County Fair Board.
 - b. She must provide her own chaperone per State Fair Queen contest rules.
5. If Miss of Jr Miss Callaway County fails to complete her term, the title will be passed to the runner-up in order of their rank, beginning with the first runner-up.
6. The 2010 queens will agree to be available to return in July 2011 to assist with the preliminary competition and to crown the new queens. They will not be able to compete for the consecutive year in the same age division.
