RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Callaway County Pageant competition is held annually in conjunction with the Fulton Street Fair. Entrants agree to abide by all rules of the Missouri State Fair Pageant and The Callaway County Pageant that are in effect now or as announced later. Entrants agree that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely at the discretion of the Callaway County Pageant Directors and the decision of the judges will be final. Entrants agree to pay an entry fee of \$25

1. Contestants shall be citizens of the United States.
2. Contestants shall be female and residents of the county of Callaway for not fewer than six months immediately preceding July 4, 2011.
3. Contestants shall be single and not cohabiting with a male.
4. Contestants shall be not less than 17 nor more than 22 years of age on September 1, 2011. Jr. Miss contestant shall be not less than 13 nor more than 16 years of age on September 1, 2011
5. Entries shall be postmarked no later than June 1, 2011
6. Entry fees and the official entry form must be sent to the Callaway County Pageant Directors, 2284 State Road A, Auxvasse, MO 65231. All other forms including the 5 x 7 photograph, may be emailed to tlbp7c@mail.missouri.edu.
7. A complete entry will include the following:
 - a) \$25.00 entry fee.
 - b) Completed official entry form.
 - d) One 5" x 7" color photograph or color photocopy. Emailed to tlbp7c@mail.missouri.edu
 - e) Completed information sheet for the Emcee.
8. Contestants must register at a time and place to be named by the director of the pageant.
9. The queen, the four runners-up, and award winners will remain for a short time immediately following the coronation for publicity photographs.

10. Miss Callaway County will automatically relinquish her title if she enters into a marriage contract or if she chooses to cohabit with a male in lieu of a marriage contract.

11. Conduct deemed to be improper and detrimental to the Callaway County or the pageant will be reason for disqualification and dismissal by the director.

12. If Miss Callaway County fails to complete her term, the title will be passed to the runners-up in the order of their rank, beginning with the first runner-up.

15. The Callaway County Pageant Board does not guarantee premium money, merchandise, prizes or special award.

OBLIGATIONS

1.If crowned Miss Callaway, or Junior Miss Callaway, you will be expected to be present at the fair each evening to promote events during the different venues that are taking place at the fair.

2. The queens should attend the Callaway County Fair Ham Breakfast on Saturday, August 6th, 2011. ***This is an early morning event.***

3. The queens are expected to ride in the winter Fulton parade for 2011.

4. The queens are expected to ride in the Street Fair Parade following the Pageant.

(Cars will be provide)

5. The queens are expected to attend the activities of the Street Fair for 2012

13. Selection of the queen will be based on the following scoring basis:

40% Personal interviews

40% Public speaking or talent performance

20% Evening gown- Optional for Jr. Miss but Business Professional must replace evening gown.

14. The Queen and the three runners-up will receive a scholarship to the Missouri college or university of their choice and prizes will be determined

6.The queens are expected to be open to attend other events during the year that are demanded necessary.

7. Miss Callaway County may compete at either the Missouri State Fair Queen Contest in Sedalia or Miss Missouri in Mexico next June.

Her entry fees will be paid by the Callaway County Pageant Board.

She must provide her own chaperone per State Fair Queen contest rules.

8. The 2011 queens will agree to be available to return in June 2012 to assist with the preliminary competition and to crown the new queens. They will not be able to compete for the consecutive year in the same age division.
