

KINGDOM OF CALLAWAY FAIR STOCK DERBY RULES FOR 2009. 1980 & NEWER ONLY!!! NO PREVIOUSLY RUN DERBY CARS

NO WELDING PERIOD!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

\$32.00 Car Entry Fee Includes Driver Pass (\$12.00 at gate & \$20.00 at pit). \$17.00 Pit Pass (12.00 at gate & 5.00 at pit)

CHECK IN WILL BEGIN AT 5:30 PM FOR EACH DERBY AND PRIZE MONEY WILL BE BASED ON A REGISTERED CARS.

Stock Derby Prize Money: Based on number of cars the night of the derby

Participant Rules: PLEASE READ ALL RULES—IT'S IMPORTANT

1 All persons MUST sign Pit entry form, insurance waiver, release form and purchase a pit pass BEFORE entering the Pit Area.

2 No one is allowed in the race area under the influence of liquor. Possession of alcoholic beverages in pit area will result in loss of pit pass and expulsion from the pits.

3 All hoods and trunks must be opened at check in. No folding or tucking trunk lids

4 All drivers must be 16 years of age or older, and MUST be able to provide proof of age at the request of the Kingdom of Callaway County Fair Officials. Drivers under the age of 18 MUST have a legal guardian sign a Minor Wavier and Release Forms. **NO EXCEPTION!!!! NO CAGES ALLOWED.**

Automobile Body Regulations:

1 Passenger Cars, Only coil spring Wagons or Cars (NO LEAF SPRING'S), or (NO Convertibles) No Trucks, Jeeps, Hearses, or Limousines. No Chrysler Imperials. No car previously run in a demolition derby will be allowed Cars must remain stock (i.e. Chevy on Chevy, Ford on Ford, Dodge on Dodge, and Pontiac on Pontiac etc...) NO LEAF SPRINGS VEHICLES OR LINCOLNS PERIOD!!!

2 All cars must have front doors painted white with black numbers your choice 1 to 100. No other writing on these white doors. Special numbers will be allowed subject to the approval of Kingdom of Callaway County Officials. Absolutely no Profanity will be allowed to be displayed on any portion of the car —remember there will be families watching.

3 All glass must be removed (Side Windows, Head and Tail Lights)

4 Drivers MUST wear an approved face shield.

5 Rear seats of sedan must be removed. Station wagons all seats and decking must be removed. Station wagons must be emptied to floor boards. All cars must be swept clean –both drivers compartment and trunk. No spare tires, broken glass or trash, etc. allowed in cars.

6 All cars must have approved seat belts, secured to or around frame. Safety is a Must!!

7 Battery must be securely fastened and covered in the front seat passenger floor board. Only one automotive type battery allowed.

8 Any type automotive radiator may be used but it must be mounted in stock position. At drivers option they may compete without radiator, but must run on water in the block only. Nor reserve tanks allowed. No Trans Cooler's allowed.

9 NO WELDING PERIOD!!!!!! Doors must be LIGHTLY wired or chained shut. A piece of steel may be bolted on Driver's door not to exceed the length of the driver's door. The piece of steel may not be wider than 10 inches

10 Stock gas tanks MUST be removed from original position and mounted in the rear seat area and secured by existing seat belts or added metal straps. No Chains or rubber straps or round bottom tanks. A Marine (Boat) Tank is recommended. All tanks must have a secure cap. All lines and fittings must be leak proof and meet the approval of the Kingdom of Callaway County Fair Officials. Electric fuel pumps are permitted but MUST have shut off within reach of driver. **NO MORE THAN 3 GALLONS OF GAS IN THE TANK!!!**

11 Fender and bumper ends may be trimmed to allow for wheel clearance. Bumpers must remain factory. 1972 and older must run stock shock front bumpers. No welding or chain on bumpers allowed lightly wired no more than 2 pieces of #9 wire holding bumper to car. (Remember STOCK MEANS STOCK)

12 Hoods must have 2 holes at least 4 inches in diameter, on each side of the carburetor, not directly on top of carburetor. If hood is removed, either fan blade must be removed or fan belt must be cut. No exhaust pipes sticking out of the hood. A SAFETY REQUIREMENT FOR THE HOOD. So it will not come in and cause injury to the driver. This requirement will be at least 3 straps up to 4 1/8 inch by 2 inch wide, bolted from the firewall and to the top of the car above the windshield area.

13 On all cars-hoods, trunks and tailgates must open for inspection by derby officials. A small amount of wire, light chain. Trunks, and tailgates, but all such devices must be installed at the derby site AFTER inspection. No all thread rods through the frame and hood or frame and trunk allowed. The wire or strap must not be more than 2 inches wide

14 Suspension must remain strictly stock. No Shock modifications allowed. Do not crank up torsion bar suspension on Chrysler Corp. Cars.

15 Trailer hitches, Class 1 or frame mounted must be totally removed. Class B or bumper mounted, trailer ball stub must be cut off

16 No welding on frame

17 All body mounts remain in the stock position, removal not allowed.

Engine, Transmission, Rear End Regulations

1 Engine must be stock only (I.e. GM on GM, Ford on Ford, Dodge on Dodge, and Pontiac on Pontiac etc....)

2 Engine cooling system must be drained and flushed free from anti-freeze. Air conditioner Freon 22 must be properly evacuated from the system. The must be accomplished before arrival at the derby.

3 No chained, welded or homemade motor mounts will be permitted, but bolted mounts are permitted

4 No headers allowed of any type.

5 Stock only automobiles rear end (no trucks or floater rear ends allowed) can be used in any car. Stock only, no welding gears rear ends must be stock. You cannot transform a coil spring to leaf spring or vice versa. All cars will be required to have a stock giver or bounce, and must be approved by derby officials. (REMEMBER STOCK MEANS STOCK) NO LEAF SPRING CARS.) NO LOCKING REAR WHEEL DRIVE MUST BE SINGLE DRIVE WHEEL ONLY!!!!!!)

6 Stock driveshafts and U-Joints. No welding of driveshaft's permitted.

7 No chain or wire over the cross member or around the rear end permitted.

Tires

1 Only fifteen (15) inch or smaller tires and wheels are allowed. NO SPLIT RIMS ALLOWED.

2 No paddle, pulling or cut tires-Conventional tread only. DOT approved only.

3 All wheels and rims must be strictly stock. No welding or reinforcing allowed.

4 No liquid in tires permitted, No studs or screws in rims to hold tires in place permitted.

5 No double tires permitted

Racing Regulations for Car Derby:

- 1 All drivers must wear approved helmets, long pants and shirt.
- 2 Entries limited to one car per driver show.
- 3 Driver must compete in car driven in heats for feature event.
- 4 A driver that receives a black flag for sandbagging or intentional door hit will be disqualified from all further completion for that night.
- 5 A driver meeting will be held by the director preceding each derby.
- 6 All Cars should sign in one hour before each race time.
- 7 All cars must be removed from the derby site by 7:00 am the following day unless otherwise stated at the drivers meeting. Failure to do this will result in cars being removed by and becoming the property of a local salvage operator.
- 8 NO OUTLAW/MODIFIED CARS ALLOWED!!! (REMEMBER STOCK ONLY)**
- 9 Only Drivers of the derby can protest
- 10 There will be a \$100.00 protest fee to protest a car. If truck is found legal then the \$100.00 is given to the driver of the protested car. If the car is found illegal the protestor will get his money back and the car will be disqualified.
- 11 If the car is found illegal after the derby, it too will be disqualified.
- 12 all decisions are final by Fair Board Committee!
